

Making a Bequest to the McCormick Arts Council at the Keturah (MACK)

Providing Art, Culture and Education to the Region.

A bequest to the McCormick Arts Council is a simple and convenient way to provide important support for McCormick County's cultural center.

We recommend you discuss all options available to bequest the MACK with your financial advisor and loved ones. Examples include making your bequest for a specific dollar amount, for a percentage of your estate, or you can name the cultural center, as contingent beneficiary should your heirs predecease you. You can designate your bequest for the MACK's general use, or you can specify its use. Individuals may choose to establish an endowment through their will that honors the memory of a family member or friend. A named endowment creates a meaningful and lasting legacy to your loved one while providing critical ongoing support to the McCormick Arts Council.

SAMPLE LANGUAGE FOR INCLUDING THE MCCORMICK ARTS COUNCIL (MACK) IN YOUR WILL

Bequest for General Purposes

I give, devise and bequeath to the McCormick Arts Council at the Keturah (MACK), a not-for-profit organization organized and existing under the law of the Commonwealth of South Carolina (ENTER LEGAL), presently located at (ADDRESS), the sum of (\$) or (% of my disposable estate) or (description of property) or (residual of estate) to be used without restriction.

Bequest for MACK Legacy Fund

I give, devise and bequeath to the McCormick Arts Council at the Keturah (MACK) a not-for-profit organization, organized and existing under the law of the Commonwealth of South Carolina (ENTER LEGAL), presently located at (ADDRESS), the sum of (\$) or (% of my disposable estate) or (description of property) to go to the MACK Legacy Fund.

Bequest for Specific Purposes

I give, devise and bequeath to the McCormick Arts Council at the Keturah (MACK), a not-for-profit organization, organized and existing under the law of the Commonwealth of South Carolina (ENTER LEGAL), presently located at (ADDRESS), the sum of (\$) or (% of my disposable estate) or (description of property) or (residual of estate) to be used for (description of special purposes such as capital needs, restoration or specific programs).

Contingent Bequest

I give and bequeath the residue of the property, real and personal and wherever situate, owned by me at my death to (name heirs), if she/he/they survives me. If (named heirs) do not survive me, I give and bequeath my residuary estate to the McCormick Arts Council at the Keturah (MACK), a not-for-profit organization, organized and existing under the law of the Commonwealth of South Carolina (ENTER LEGAL), presently located at (ADDRESS), to be used without restrictions.
