He currently specializes in environmental portraiture, taking photographs of people and families in an environment where they feel comfortable. As a Photographic Craftsman degree holder (Cr. Photog.), and an Approved Business Instructor (ABI) with the Professional Photographers of America (PPA), he presents workshops around the country to professional photographers in the area of business and marketing. Ed spends his time in Augusta teaching digital photography and Photoshop classes at The Morris Museum, and the Phinzy Center for Water Sciences. He was the program developer and Lead Instructor of the Photography Certificate Program at Augusta University. Teaching photography keeps his skills current as digital technology is constantly changing. Ed is a founding member and serves on the executive board of the Augusta Photography Festival, a bi-annual celebration of the photographic arts in Augusta that attracts national speakers and photographic competition entries worldwide. One of his ongoing passions is working with the Library of Congress Veterans History Project videotaping interviews with World War II veterans.
