The purpose of the MACK Legacy Fund is to provide CPA managed funding for the long term needs of the MACK.

The leadership team for the Annual Fund is the MACK Fundraising Committee and the MACK Legacy Fund Committee.

This fund will hold large and long term gifts, especially for those with a specific purpose. The MACK will issue requests for the release of funds according to the terms of the donor's gift. All monies must be used according to the donor's wishes. Any unspecified funds that were gifted through solicitation for the MACK will be available to the MACK's general operational funds pending committee review.
